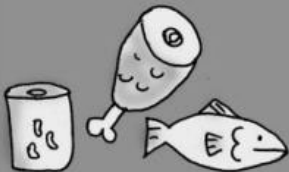
THE QUALITY OF BREAD DEPENDS ON WHO COLONIZED THE TERRITORY.

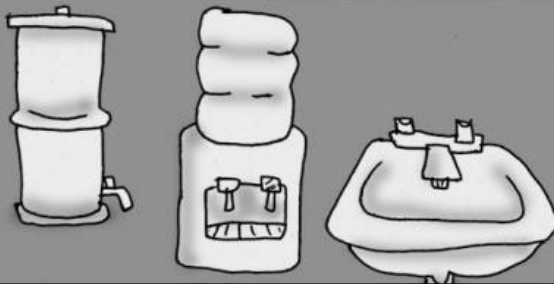

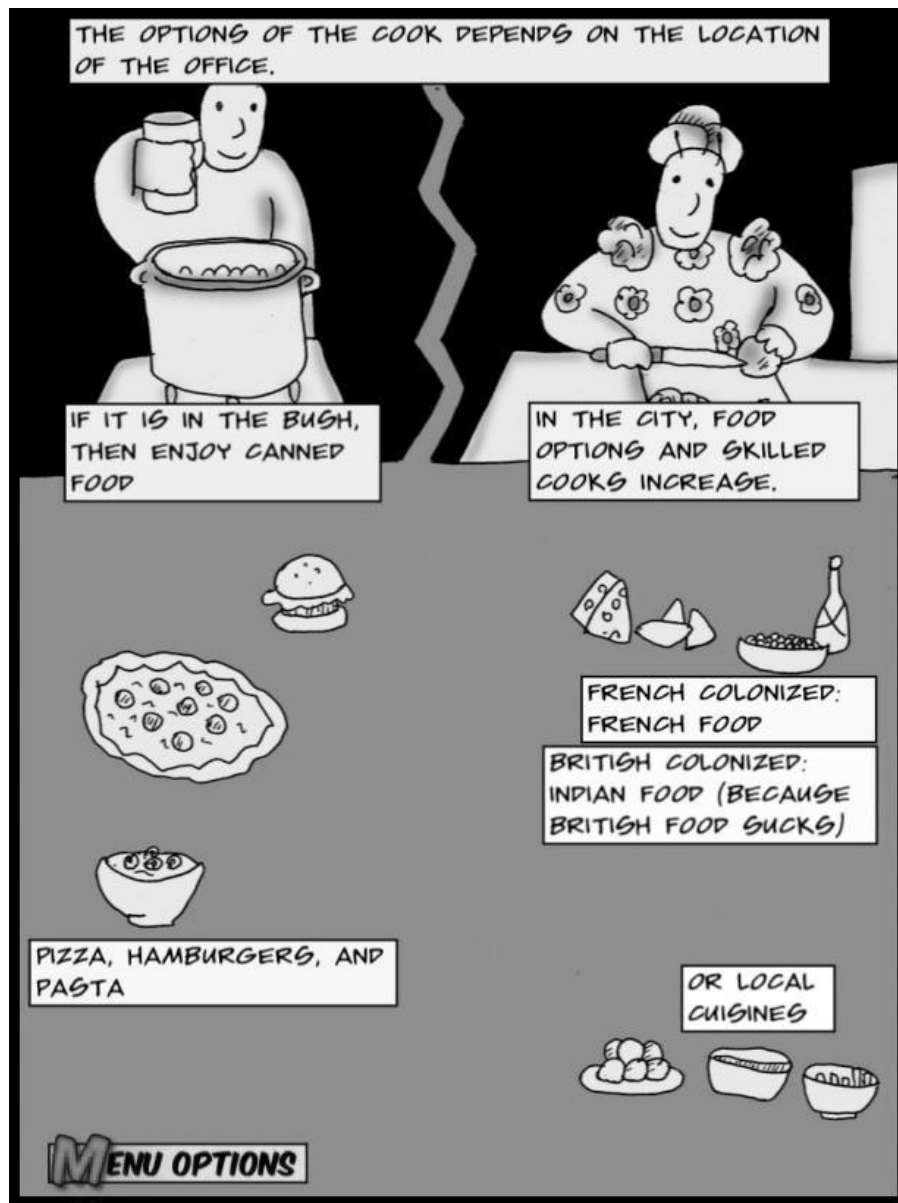

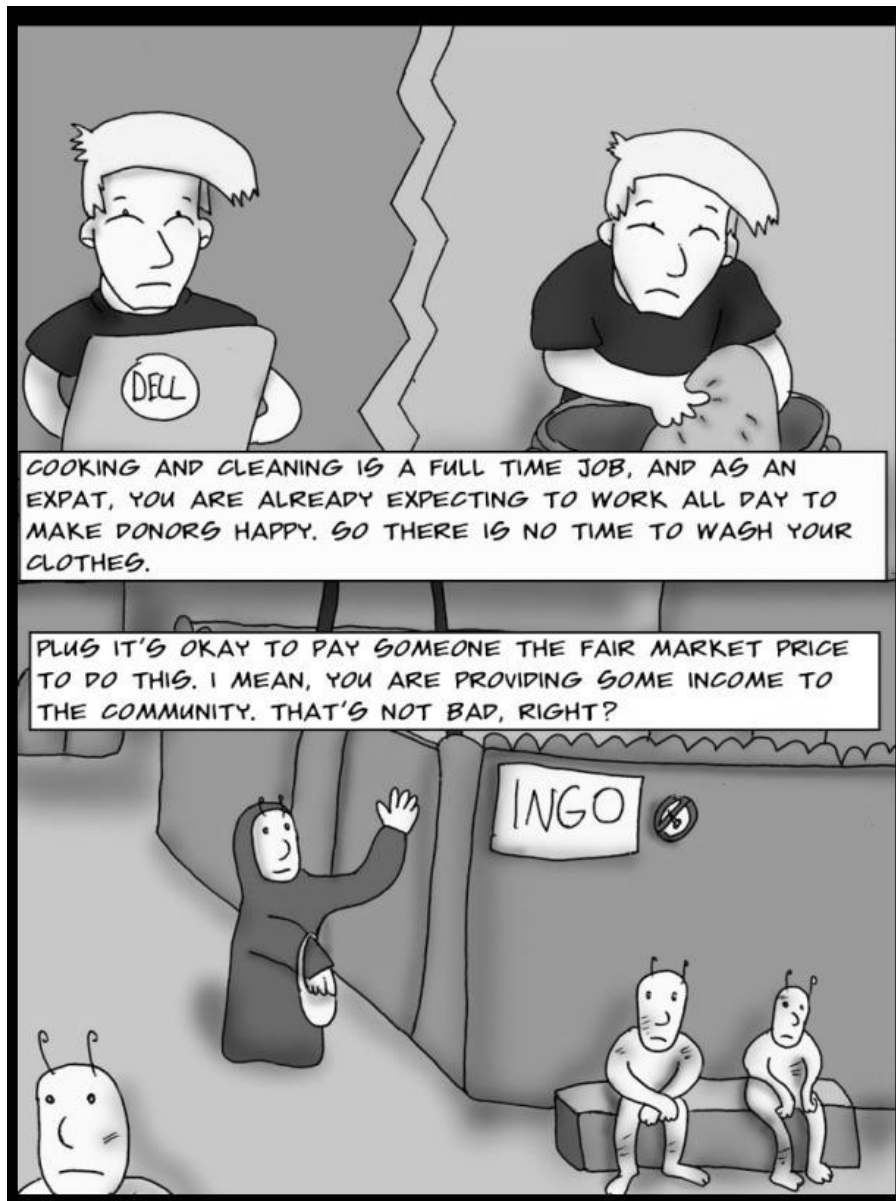






CLEANERS IN THE CAPITAL ALSO HAVE IT MUCH EASIER THAN THE CLEANERS IN THE FIELD OFFICE.

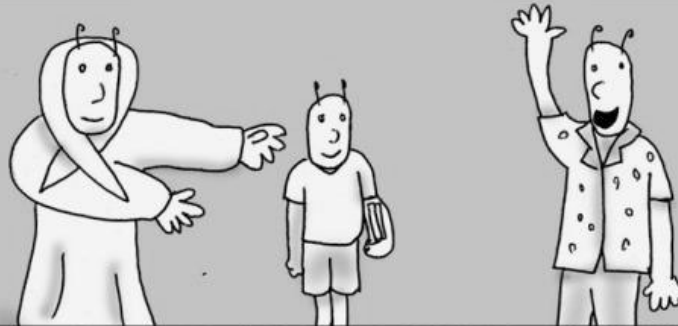
